NOMINATION FORM *Divisional Representative*

Divisional Representatives form part of the Master Builders Electoral College (MBEC), which is elected by members. Divisional Representatives play a key role in representing their division at the MBEC and ensure regional representation is achieved.

The MBEC, which meets once per year, is responsible for electing the President, Housing & Construction Committee Chairs and other members of Master Builders' Board. The MBEC is made up of between 25 and 45 eligible members, including nine Divisional Representatives (one per division), with appropriate industry qualifications and experience and an interest in industry issues. MBEC members will also be invited to nominate for positions on the Housing and Construction Sector Committees.

Divisional Representatives are automatically elected to the MBEC and will sit on their respective Divisional Committee of Management.
